MAY

- **Friday, May 19th, 10am-8pm & Saturday, May 20th, 9am-7pm: *Wyoming Outdoor Weekend & Expo, Lander Community Center, Lander, WY***— This free event is in its third year and celebrates different ways to get outside and have fun. The National Bighorn Sheep Center will have an educational booth and activities focused on bighorn sheep, habitat and wildlife resources. Come visit us both days!
- **Thursday, May 25th, 7pm: *A Night with the Mountain Shoshone***— Explore the world of the Mountain Shoshone Indians with Tory Taylor in a presentation featuring Shoshonean cooking baskets and a book signing.
- **Saturday, May 27th, 10am-2pm: *Torrey Valley Wildlife Tracking Trek***— Join our Education Team for a late-spring wildlife exploration of the Torrey Valley area. Participants will learn about the stories wildlife leave behind including scat, tracks and sign and we will demonstrate plaster casting of wildlife tracks.
