Registration Schedule:

Tuition must be paid in full at time of registration, \$2,195. Cancellations before Wednesday June 1st 2022 will be charged a non-refundable cancellation fee of \$195, if not transferred to another person.

Cancellation Policy:

Registration is nonrefundable after Wednesday June 1st, 2022. Attendee may avoid cancellation fee and receive a full refund if he/she finds another individual to take his/her place.

Health and Physical Capability Requirements:

Participants should be in good health, able to step onto and off a vehicle frequently, able to stand in place for up to an hour, and able to walk up to a 1/4 mile at a time with a single camera/lens. Participants will also need to carry their camera bag a short distance a couple of times. If eye-level photographs are desired, participants will need to be able to kneel and get back up to a standing position without the need to grab and hold the fence.

Below is a RELEASE of LEGAL RIGHTS – **Please READ the Release carefully before signing.**

1. I acknowledge and understand that participation in hiking, fieldwork, and wildlife watching inherent risks, hazards, and dangers for anyone that cannot be eliminated, particularly in an outdoor and/or wilderness environment. I understand that these risks, hazards, and dangers include the risk of physical injury from:

- Hiking and working in rugged country;
- Encounters with wildlife, animals and insects;
- Temperature extremes and inclement weather conditions;
- Altitudes of approximately 7,000+ ft. in high desert;
- Unavailability of immediate medical attention in case of injury in the wilderness.

2. I fully understand the risks, hazards, and dangers described above and have had the opportunity to discuss them. I understand that these activities may require good physical conditioning and the degree of skill and knowledge necessary for me to engage in these activities safely. I understand that I have responsibilities for my own safety and to follow any instructions of the National Bighorn Sheep Center with regard to these activities. My participation in these activities is purely voluntary and I elect to participate in spite of the risks.

3. In consideration for participation in these activities, and to the extent permitted by law, I do hereby release, hold harmless and indemnify the National Bighorn Sheep Center, its principals, directors, officers, agents employees, and volunteers from and against any and all present or future claims, loss or liability for injury which I may suffer or for which I may be liable to any other person and for any and all claims for damages, costs, fees (including attorneys' fees and costs) which may result from my participation in these activities.

4. These terms shall serve as a waiver and release for me, my heirs, estate, executors, administrators, and for all members of my family. I have read the above statement and fully understand the contents, consequences and implications of signing this document.
