We begin with a walk-through of our exhibits, introducing you to the history of the indigenous peoples known as the sheep eaters, current challenges that face wild sheep and management efforts, and the wild sheep ecosystem.

Our outdoor excursion is located at the Whiskey Basin Wildlife Habitat Management Area, the wintering habitat for our beloved herd of bighorn sheep. Although wildlife sightings are not guaranteed, bighorn sheep become significantly more tolerant of human activity during rut.
