

Camp Bighorn 2025

An Outdoor, Nature-Based, Educational Day-Camp Whiskey Mountain Conservation Camp, Dubois, WY

Youth develop a new set of resources in an outdoor setting, creating a lifelong imprint on their relationship to the environment, wildlife, and natural spaces. All Camp Bighorn programs focus on bighorn sheep and the conservation of wildlife and wildlands.

Audience: Youth ages 9 - 12

When: June 30 - July 5; 9 am - 4 pm (No Camp on July 4th due to holiday).

Where: Whiskey Mountain Conservation Camp, Dubois, Wyoming

What: 5 days of educational and physical activities such as field journaling, wild edible and medicinal plants, water ecology, Sheepeater Indian history and petroglyph exploration, kayaking, archery, bighorn sheep biology, birding and ecology! (Activities differ each year.)

Cost:

<u>Day-Camp Only Option</u> - \$375 which includes a \$50 deposit, \$300 camper tuition, and lunch and snacks.

<u>All-Inclusive Option</u> - \$650 which includes a \$50 deposit, \$300 camper tuition, lodging and meals for ONE parent + ONE youth. Lodging and meals are provided for the entire week except no meals provided on July 4th.
